Research Procedures

Researchers must complete a Research Agreement Form prior to accessing the collection or archives in the Museum.

Access to the collection and archives will be through the Curator and the Museum staff.

Some collections may contain medical information or material of a private and sensitive nature relating to individuals. The researcher should not publish or communicate to any other person the names or other particulars of individuals so named in the records. The researcher bears the responsibility for taking whatever measures are necessary to protect individual privacy.

Under Canadian law, copyright to unpublished material resides with the Curator. As a general rule substantial portions of a document may not be quoted, paraphrased or used in any way without the consent of the Curator. Researchers are reminded that the onus for satisfying the legal requirements of the legislation rests with them.
